Camp Regulations Must Read/Must Sign

Sponsors

Sponsors have the final word in all matters pertaining to camp discipline and policy.

Christ-like/Respectable Behavior

Each person at camp is expected to conduct himself/herself in a Christian manner at all times as follows:

1. Have a respectful behavior at ALL time.
2. Attend all classes and worship services each day. Sickness or confinement to bed is the only exception.
3. Have a same gender friend with you when you go from one activity to another while at camp.
4. Be dressed according to the dress code. (Green Country regulations as stated below.)
5. Eat a balanced meal every time a meal is offered. Stay hydrated; drink plenty of water.
6. No public displays of affection or inappropriate touching will be tolerated at camp. Any infractions can result in required police involvement and being sent home at the expense of the student's family.
7. No water fights, rock throwing, or shave cream fights will be waged. Serious results have come from this activity.
8. Bring only prescription medication to camp. The camp nurse will take care of ALL medication.
9. No camper shall leave the grounds unless accompanied by two ADULT sponsors.

Dress Code/Clothing

1. All shorts will be at least mid-length, (between the hip joint and the knee).
2. No halter tops, mid-riffs or spaghetti straps. Tank top straps must be 3" wide or wider. No netting-like or transparent garments shall be worn alone by a camper/sponsor. Garments advertising; profanity, alcoholic beverages or tobacco are not allowed. Shirts and shoes shall be worn at all times.
3. We will receive our camp t-shirts when we arrive at camp.

Property Damage

Any property destroyed will be replaced by the guilty party.

Showers

Everyone will take a shower each day.

Drugs, Fireworks, & Weapons

No weapons, No tobacco of any kind, No drugs including alcohol is allowed anywhere on the camp grounds.

Dorm Rules

Each person staying at camp shall be in the cabin each evening for devotional.

Quiet time for the night begins with "light out" and all occupants of the cabin shall observe this rule.

Each person shall maintain cleanliness around their bunk and in the dining hall and in corporate gathering places. Don't be a litter bug!!!

Electronic Devices

Cell phones, iPods, iPads, electronic games, radios, etc. are **NOT** allowed at camp. Any abuse of this will result in the confiscation of the device until we return to church from camp.

Recreation

Recreational activities are scheduled for each afternoon. Sports, hiking, & swimming are enjoyed during these hours. Coed swimming is not permitted; capets, robes, or other knee length; non-translucent apparel must be worn while going to and from the swimming area.

FUN!

Have as much fun as possible without breaking these or other stated rules!

Homesickness could/does happen. It will pass!!! Please, do not arrive at camp to pick up your child without first talking to a sponsor.

Any camp sponsor (adult or youth) or camper who is openly defiant to any adult leader or does not comply with these or other stated rules can be sent home at the expense of the camper's family.

I have read the above rules and regulations and understand what is expected of any sponsor or my child while at camp. I further understand that if my child violates any of the above, he/she forfeits his/her right to remain at camp and will be sent home at ones or parents' expense.

Registration includes:

- Online group registration form and payment
- Online individual registration for campers and sponsors
- Online background check validation. A hard copy should be provided.
- Church Certificate of Insurance provided either before or 1st day.

Forms- **All** sponsors, children, and youth must be registered online from each group's specific link. Rosters may be generated by each group leader.

Shirts- Shirt reservations need to be in a **minimum** 2 weeks before your camp begins. Reservations after the 2 week deadline will be \$12. You can send in reservations on our website in the Leader Portal. Final orders will be paid for with group registration.

Church Certificate of Insurance- Churches need to provide a **Certificate of Insurance** showing coverage. Contact your insurance company for this typical, standard document and have it ready at registration.

Background Checks- Churches must provide a copy of the background checks for everyone over 18. Fill out the form online but either email or provide a hard copy of the first page to the camp.

One day visitors- Visitors will be limited to Church Staff only. Visitors will be required to check in with GCC staff upon arrival must be accompanied by a church sponsor at all times.

Extra meals- Extra meals must be purchased at registration. Meal cards will then be collected at the front door for each meal. We will not accept \$\$ at the door.

Sponsor ratio- We require a minimum of 1 sponsor for every 7 students

Free time will include Laser Tag, Miniature Golf, Basketball, Tetherball, Disc golf and Sugar Shack games, Screamer Swing, and Rock Wall (as indicated on schedule). Zip line will be scheduled during free time. All staff are certified and trained in the areas they operate.

Rec field will be open for use during free time, but no planned activities will be led by any GCC staff or youth volunteers. Many supplies for Rec are available to use, but must be reserved through GCC staff.

Bible Study will be an interactive experience in the Chapel with GCC staff and the camp pastor.

Missions will be in the Dining Hall.

Morning Sponsor meeting from each group in the Dining Hall meeting room next to the First Aid after breakfast.

Team Points are earned throughout the week. Churches are divided into blue, green, or yellow teams upon arrival. They are earned through: scripture memory; sharing ones testimony; service; scavenger hunts; and attitude. Bracelets are given as points by staff members. Bracelets are then collected each morning at Celebration and tallied.

Celebration is a time in the Chapel of energizing action to get everyone excited about the day and its activities.

Afterglow is an evening in-cabin devotional for the purpose of fellowship, teaching, commitment, and celebration.

Lost & Found items need to be placed on the front left stage area located in the Conference Center.

Mail from parents & family should be sent by Saturday of the preceding week to insure arrival during the camp. Please mail to: Camper's Name of _____ Church; PO Box 40; Disney, OK. 74340

The Sugar Shack will be open during the day and after evening chapel. Concessions and gift shop items may be purchased with Sugar Shack cards. Extra cards may be purchased for \$5.



GREEN COUNTRY CAMP CAMP RULES AND GUIDELINES

- GCC is a Christian camp and all rules are to help us to reflect Christ in our conduct.
- Please respect all camp properties just as you would at the church you attend. We ask you to assist in keeping the grounds clean of trash. Cans are provided camp wide to contain debris.
- MEDICINAL MARIJUANA, Illegal drugs, alcohol, knives, ANY form of tobacco, guns, skateboards, and fireworks are not permitted.
- If property or equipment is damaged, your group will be held responsible for any cost incurred for repair or replacement.
- If dorm room is excessively filthy during your stay or upon departure, your church will be assessed a fine of at least \$100.
- GCC requires two adult sponsors in each dorm room. Sponsors must be at least 18 years old with a background check.
- Shoes must be worn at all times (unless a camper is in the pool, on sand volleyball courts, or on Rec field).
- No clothing which is revealing, suggestive, or advertises alcohol or tobacco products will be allowed.
- Swimsuits must be modest - no bikini- or monokini-style or a colored t-shirt must be worn while at the pool. Lifeguards have discretion and can eject anyone not properly clothed from pool area.
- Shaving cream fights, water fights, etc. will not be tolerated. A group doing such in or near enough a building to cause damage, will face a charge of at least \$100.
- No use of the Zip line, laser tag, inflatables, water slide, or pool is allowed unless GCC authorized, trained personnel are present.
- Campers are not allowed to enter dorms of campers of the opposite sex. **Campers will use gender-at-birth dorms only.**
- Campers are not allowed to leave the campgrounds while at camp unless under direction of lead sponsor.
- Campers must attend all scheduled sessions and activities.
- Campers are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle at camp. Sponsors may ride in vehicles driven by approved sponsors.
- Campers are not allowed to share ANY medication belonging to them with any other camper.
- No golf carts, four-wheelers, or ATVs of any kind are allowed on camp except those used by the camp staff or unless pre-approved by camp management.
- No food and/or drink items are allowed in Chapel or Sleeping areas.
- Counselors must accompany campers leaving dorms for any reason after lights out.
- All campers must be accompanied by a sponsor to the First Aid Station for treatment.
- Pastors & sponsors will be responsible for the conduct of their campers. Extreme discipline problems will be brought to the Camp Administrator &/or appropriate GCC leadership.
- No unauthorized person will be allowed on grounds. **Visitors are restricted to approved church staff with background checks.**
- Cell phones may be used ONLY to communicate with parents & are limited to use in your cabin.

All of the above rules are designed to provide a Christian atmosphere, a safe and healthy environment, and provide for the respect of the camp and facilities. Please see to it that all campers are aware of these rules before your event begins.

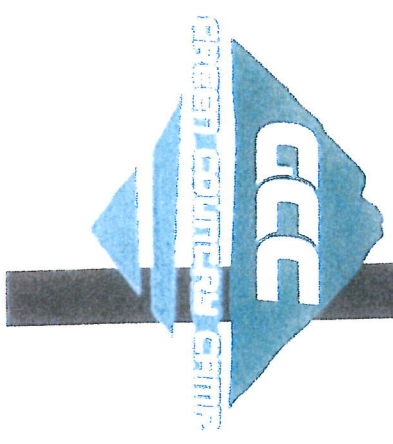
